150th Anniversary Homecoming

Lottie was born in 1840. Her name was Charlotte Moon, but everyone called her "Lottie." She was 4'9" tall. She was appointed to China as a missionary in 1873 (one year after our church was getting started, just to give you some history.) She wore Chinese clothes and lived like her Chinese neighbors. Lottie had several nicknames in China--foreign devil, foreign lady teacher, heavenly book visitor, and the cookie maker. Lottie would bake cookies to win the hearts of the children and families who were frightened of her. She served and brought the gospel to the people of China, specifically Tengchow and Pingtu, for 39 years. Today, we still give to the Lottie Moon Christmas offering during the months of November and December in honor of her work and sacrifice to keep our missionaries on the field.
