Boston Baptist Sesquicentennial Spotlight



Mrs. Ola Norton

The ladies of Boston Baptist Church were appointed as a Mission Committee. In a session of Mercer Association meeting with Hickory Head Church, September 29, 1876, Resolution III, the sisters were requested to organize in each church a "Woman's Mission" or "Women's Society". Here for the first time, the sisters came into public recognition in our association as a live force in church work. Mrs. A.E. Parramore was the first president. Their first report sent on October 9, 1866, is as follows:

Foreign Missions \$5.50, Home Missions \$2.50, Association Missions \$14.00, State Missions \$5.00, Mercer Students \$5.00. In 1888 the Boston Baptist Church Women's Society became a member of the Woman's Missionary Union Auxiliary to the Southern Baptist Convention which was organized on May 11, 1888. Mrs. Ola Norton served as president of the W.M.U. The Woman's Missionary Union of Boston Baptist Church had a vision of a mission in the Newark community- on February 4, 1962, the Boston Baptist organized and sponsored the Newark Baptist Mission.
